Customs, Immigration, Quarantine & Port Clearance (CIQP)

Food & Water:

- Free bottled water will be available at all times. This should only be used for drinking as we will supply for a consumption of 2 litres per person per day and therefore be limited beyond that.
- There is a temporary covered food area with BBQ's, boiling water and a selection of canned produce, fresh meat, fish, fruit and vegetables.
- Ice will be readily available to purchase from the village but it is only for cooling and not advised to be used as drinking ice.

Environmental Policy

In our ongoing efforts to minimize the impact of our presence in the beautiful waters and islands for which we are bound we thought it might be good to let you know what to expect:

No plastic drink bottles.

Drinking water will be provided for you. Past experience says 2 litres per day per person. We supply (recyclable) 19 litre containers and a hand pump. You supply your own sports drinking bottles (that's right, we are not supplying them this year). We ask every boat to carry at least 1 x 19 litre container at all times.

On the island - plates, cutlery and drinking glasses will be provided. We ask only that you wash your own kit after each meal. We do not have enough support staff to do that for you.

The same goes for the island Bar. If you are served your first drink in a cup, bring it back for the second. Repeat until full.

Beer will be in cans as kegs have proven too difficult to arrange. Please crush the cans and deposit in the bins/bags provided. This year we want to bring the empties (inc bottles) back with us as the villagers have no access to recycling facilities and can only burn and bury.
